History

The Whaley House was a family home that housed a granary, the County Court House, San Diego's first commercial theatre, various businesses including Thomas Whaley's own general store, a ballroom, a billiard hall, school, and polling place.

There were a few unsavoury events which affected the Whaley's, one of them being the suicide of Violet Whaley in 1885. These events, as well as the hangings which occurred on the property before the house was constructed, have suffused the Whaley House with an air of mystery.

The alleged hauntings of the Whaley House have been reported on numerous TV shows over the years. The Whaley House had been reported as Americas No1 haunted house.

Hallway

Frequent spiking of EMF in the hallway, close to the staircase

Courthouse

Frequent EMF spiking in the courtroom, mainly on right hand side.

Grounds

Frequent EMF spiking in the garden area.

With the Whaley house being situated on a main street, any audio could not be determined due to outdoor noise.
